Attendance

In accordance with advice given to us by Edwina Langley, the Attendance Lead for Birmingham, we are now in the process of running an Attendance Spotlight campaign with some families whose children's attendance has been causing us concern. Obviously, the aim of this campaign is to improve the attendance of the children concerned. However, if it does not improve over the course of the campaign, unfortunately, this will result in court action having to be followed.

We would like to remind you that, if your child's attendance drops below 92%, we cannot authorise any more absences unless we have medical proof or you come and discuss with us what is happening. Obviously, if a child is seriously ill, we would not expect them to attend school but, as stated above, please keep us informed.

Leave in Term Time

Updated guidance has recently been issued for schools regarding leave in term time. Please note that a headteacher can only authorise absences in term time in very exceptional circumstances. If parents still decide to take their children on leave in term time, their absence will be marked as unauthorised and may result in the Local Authority issuing a penalty notice for each absent child and a fine being payable.
