#### Overall Attendance and Punctuality Figures for the Year

The number of lates for the whole year averaged at 58.3 per week excluding Reception and 68.7per week including Reception.

As always, we would like to thank all those parents who ensure their children attend school every day and on time and we sincerely hope we can improve on the above figures over the coming year.
