Parents/carers and other visitors:

-  We request that parents/carers and visitors do not use mobile phones or any other device capable of recording images in the school building or grounds unless in an emergency.
-  Mobile phones or any other device capable of recording images must never be used to take photographs in the school building or grounds unless permission is granted by the Senior Leadership Team.
-  Visitors will be asked to switch off their mobile phones whilst on the school premises and to refrain from using them.
