Are you hungry for new books? Is it time to refresh your bookcase?

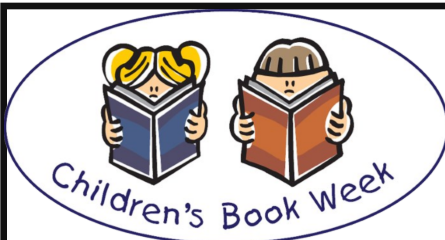
